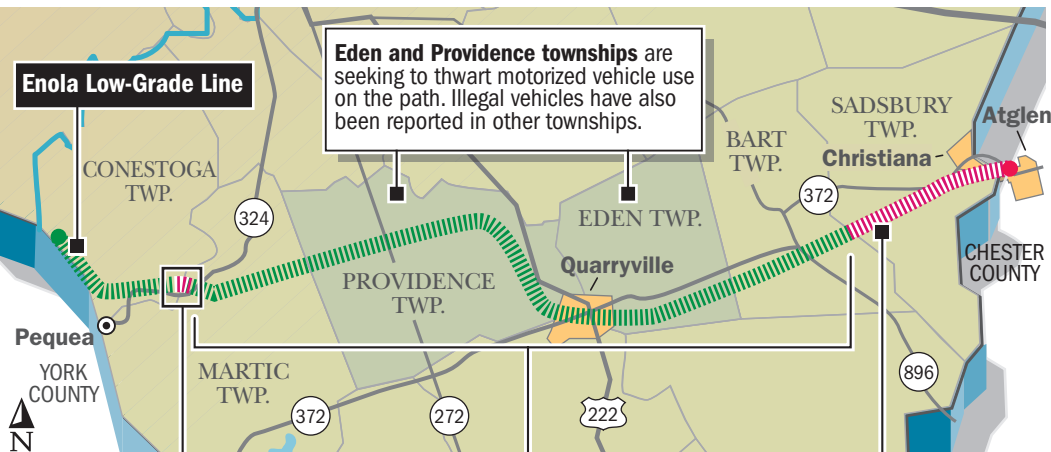


# Atglen-Susquehanna line

The **Martic Forge trestle** over the Pequea Creek is closed and causes a gap in the trail. Other bridges have been removed but don't hinder passage.
