**COUNT 1: UNLAWFUL USE OF COMPUTER AND OTHER COMPUTER CRIMES  
18 Pa.C.S.A. § 7611 (a)(3) – Felony**

In that the Defendant, while in the elected position of Lancaster County Coroner, and having authorization given to him from Lancaster County-Wide Communications to access a user name/password protected secured computer website, did intentionally or knowingly give his confidential user name and password to other persons without authorization from Lancaster County-Wide Communications.

**COUNT 2: CRIMINAL CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT UNLAWFUL USE OF COMPUTER AND OTHER COMPUTER CRIMES  
18 Pa.C.S.A. § 903 (a)(1)(2) / 7611 (a)(2) – Felony**

In that the Defendant, while in the elected position of Lancaster County Coroner, and having authorization given from Lancaster County-Wide Communications to access a user name/password protected secured computer website, did agree with certain Lancaster Intelligencer Journal reporters to engage in conduct which constitutes the crime of Unlawful use of computers or other computer crimes, and did commit an overt act in the pursuance of the conspiracy by providing his confidential user name and password to staff reporters of the Lancaster Intelligencer Journal newspaper, and encouraged the reporters to intentionally access the Lancaster County-Wide Communications secured computer website, knowing that the reporters were unauthorized by Lancaster County-Wide Communications to do so.
